




Before we had you, our biggest dream was to have a child. We are the world's luckiest and happiest parents because we got you.


Luckily, the doctor knew a very special bank. It was not a bank with money but a bank with sperm cells.

One day the doctor looked in Mummy's tummy with a special camera that is called a scanner. The doctor could see that one of Mummy's eggs was ready to make a baby.




You grew in Mummy's tummy for nine months. It felt like a LONG time. We were so excited and couldn't wait to meet you, so it was very difficult to wait.


Dearest Lilly,
